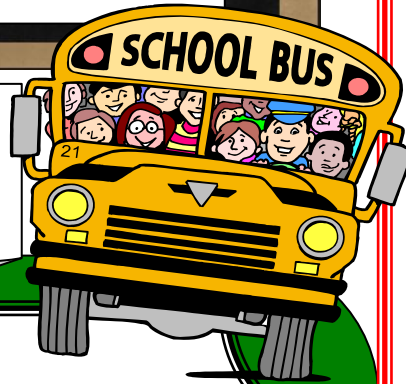

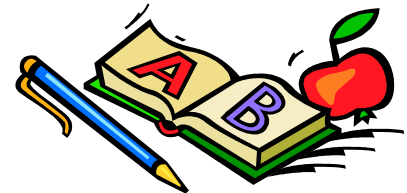
### Notes from the teacher:
