#### Writing

- ⇒ **3rd:** Students will be writing a narrative to develop real or imagined events using descriptive details.
- ⇒ **4th:** Students will be composing a persuasive writing paper, stating their opinion on a certain topic.

#### Reading

- ⇒ **3rd:** Students will be reading different informational text stories, and answering questions that go along with the story. Then they will be writing about events in the stories. They will also do the same with some nonfiction stories.
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#### Social Studies

- ⇒ **3rd:** Students will be learning about making and selling products, how business works, free enterprise, and the world marketplace.
- ⇒ **4th:** Students are reading about the Gold Rush in Idaho and Idaho's first pioneer's.

#### Science
