Standards to Learn:

Math:

- *I can multiply multi-digit whole numbers.
- *I can divide multi-digit whole numbers by whole number divisors with and without remainders using various strategies.
- *I can read, write, and compare decimals to thousandths using base ten numerals, number names, and fractional expanded form.
- *I can round decimals to a given place value in real world situations.
- *I can add, subtract, multiply and divide decimals to hundredths place using models or drawings in real world situations and explain my reasoning.

Reading:

- *I can analyze the similarities and differences of two or more characters, settings, or events in a story or drama.
- *I can analyze and explain how different plot elements work together to build a story, drama, or poem.
- *I can determine the theme and summarize a story, drama, or poem using evidence from the text.

- *I can analyze how a narrator's point of view influences how complex events are developed.

Writing:

- *I can write an informational text to thoroughly examine a topic using relevant facts, definitions, concrete details, quotations, or other information and examples related to the topic.
- *I can demonstrate a strong command of the correct verb tenses in my writing.
- *I can demonstrate a strong command of conjunctions, prepositions, and interjections and explain their function in my writing.
- *I can use commas to separate items in a series, introductory phrases or words, tag questions, and direct addresses. I can punctuate titles of work correctly.
- *I can write sentences that flow together and sound natural when read aloud. I can modify my word choice to enhance my writing.

Science:

Social Studies:

We will be learning about the 50 states and where they are located. We will also start to discuss major events in U.S. History such as the Civil War and how they impacted the nation.
