Standards to Learn in October:

Math:

* I can add, subtract, multiply and divide decimals to hundredths place using models or drawings in real world situations and explain my reasoning.

*The Highly Proficient student can add or subtract at least three of more fractions with unlike denominators including mixed numbers and use a model.

*The Highly Proficient student can solve word problems involving adding and subtracting three or more fractions with unlike denominators, including mixed numbers.

Reading:

* I can cite evidence to support an inference made from the text.

* I can analyze how a narrator's point of view influences how complex events are developed.

* I can compare, contrast, analyze, and evaluate stories in the same genre on their approaches to similar themes and topics.

*I can analyze and interpret the meaning of words or phrases in a text, including figurative language.

Writing:

* I can write an informational text to thoroughly examine a topic using relevant facts, definitions, concrete details, quotations, or other information and examples related to the topic.

* I can determine the meaning of words and phrases using context clues and reference materials in both print and digital to find the pronunciation and determine or clarify precise meaning of key words and phrases.

* I can demonstrate a strong understanding of complex language, complex word relationships and subtle nuances in word meanings like: similes, metaphors, idioms, adages, and proverbs.

*I can write sentences that flow together and sound natural when read aloud. I can modify my word choice to enhance my writing.

Science:

We will be learning about matter and its properties.

Social Studies:

We will be learning about the New World, European exploration and Native Americans. We are also learning the Preamble of the Constitution. The students will recite it at the Veterans' Day Assembly in November.
