**Reading/Writing**

1. Create and answer who, what, when, where, why questions
2. Ask and answer questions to help determine or clarify the meaning of words and phrases in a text
3. Identify and summarize the main topic and supporting details in an informational text
4. Compare and contrast the details from two informational texts on the same topic using a graphic organizer

**Math**

1. Add three or more digit numbers without regrouping, using models, drawings, and other strategies
2. Subtract multiples of 100 using concrete models, drawings, and other strategies
3. Create and solve word problems using addition and subtraction equations
