Reading/Writing

1. generate and correctly spell a list of words containing various consonant digraphs and read them aloud
2. write sentences using capital letters and correct punctuation
3. alphabetize a list of words to the second letter

Math

1. describe four digit numbers using thousands, hundreds, tens, and ones
2. compare two whole numbers greater than 200 and order three or more numbers greater than 200
