Standards-

Reading/Writing

1. Blend sounds together to decode words
2. Generate and spell words using digraphs (ex. Sh, ch, wh, th) and read them aloud
3. Write sentences with capital letters at the beginning and correct punctuation at the end

Math

1. Identify, read and write numbers to 200
2. Describe four digit numbers using thousands, hundreds, tens, and ones
3. Compare two whole numbers greater than 200 and order three or more numbers greater than 200
